***Make prayer cards or holiday cards and deliver to a senior center or health care facility**

***Help with enrichment programs at school**

***Prepare a meal for a family in need**

***Help a neighbor in need by raking leaves or shoveling snow**

***Collect and donate/bring clothes to those in need**

***Help your community on a Community or Clean up Day**
